WIMBO TROPHY – for the dog with the highest qualifying score in an Obedience class (Novice or above) and a Challenge Certificate in the Conformation Ring. For entire dogs only.

ECHO and MIDI TROPHY – for the Top Agility/Jumping dog. For all Agility and Jumping classes at Darwin Royal Show. Working on a point score system as follows.

- QUALIFYING ROUND = 10 Points
- 1ST PLACE = 5 points
- 2ND PLACE = 3 points
- 3RD PLACE = 2 points

JUNIOR HANDLER DOG COMPETITIONS

To be conducted after the Supper break on Friday night. Entry is free and will be taken on the day.

- 7 years to under 10 years
- 10 years to under 13 years
- 13 years to under 19 years

- Dogs used in Junior Handlers must be ANKC main registered
- All dogs handled must be over the age of 12 months
- Neutered dogs can compete in any handlers class
- NO bitches in season are permitted in any Junior Handler competitions
